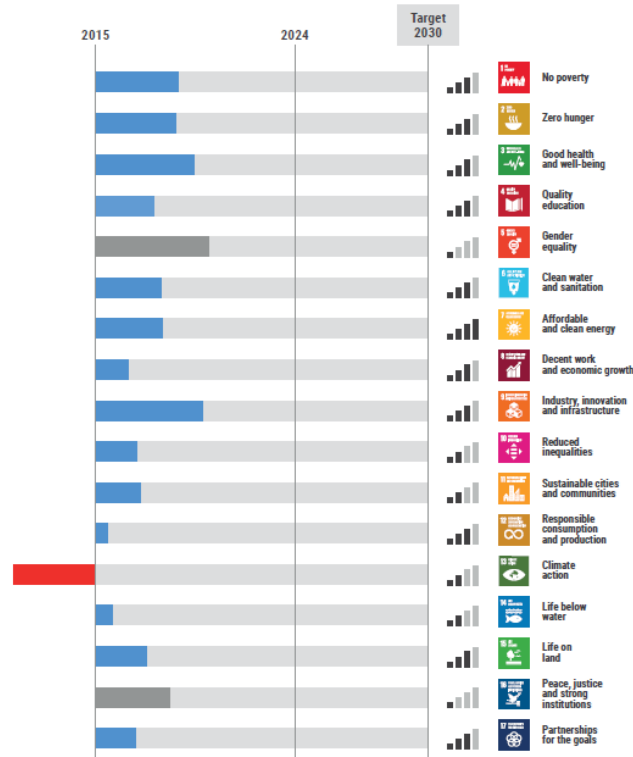

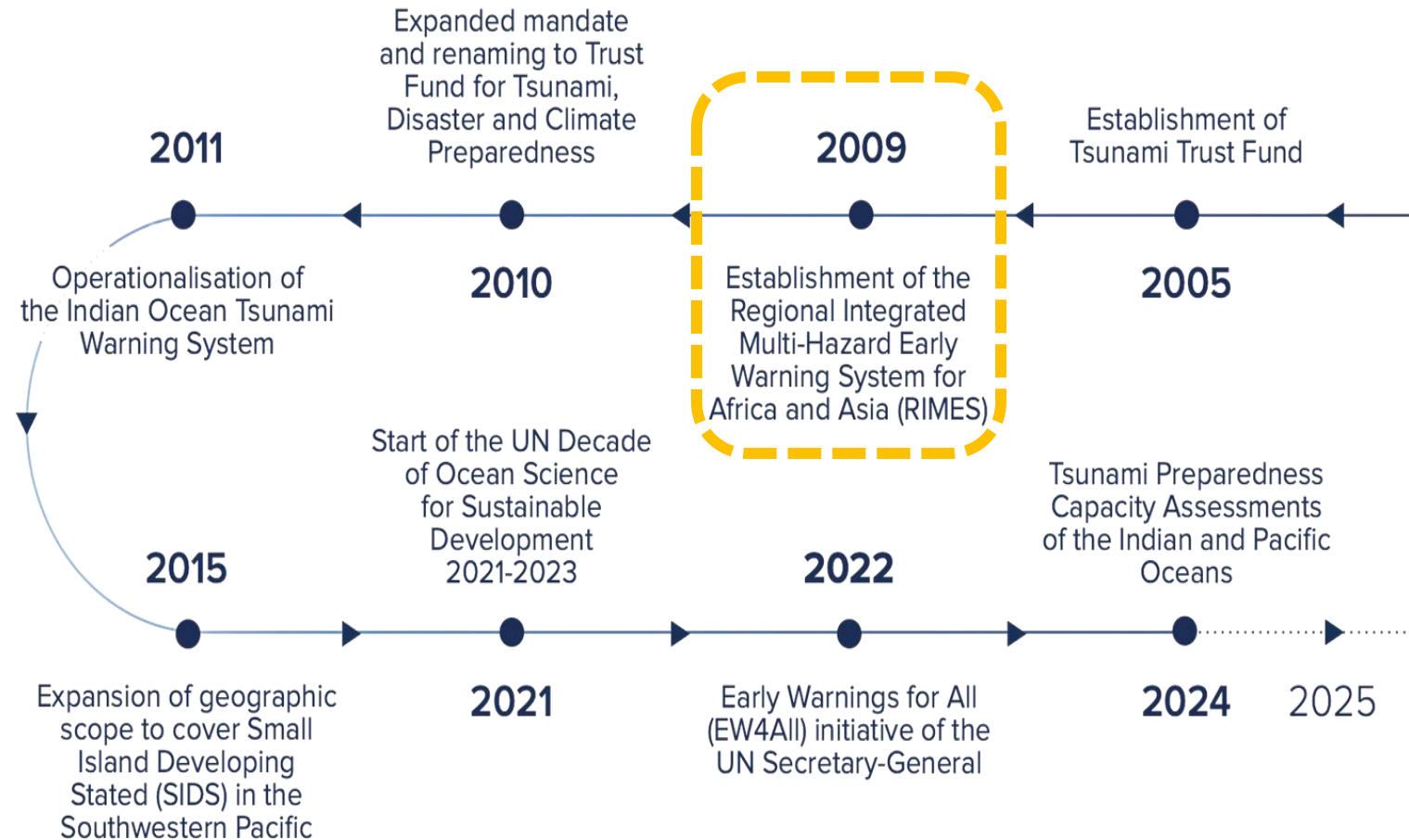


ESCAP's Trust Fund for Tsunami, Disaster and Climate Preparedness

Following the 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami, the **Multi-Donor Trust Fund for Tsunami, Disaster and Climate Preparedness** was established to address gaps in regional early warning systems.

Over **\$17 million** of regional commitment to strengthen early warning systems, directly **benefitting 23 countries**.

Investments in tsunami preparedness can also **achieve economies of scale and scope** when adapted through a multi-hazard approach.
